

Airport Manager Report:

The 2nd Annual Private Pilot Ground School is off and running with 11 students. Last year's inaugural class went very well with several of those 8 students achieving pilot ratings during last summer/fall. With an increased number of students in this year's class, this year's flying schedule should be very busy again.



Speaking of the flying schedule, the change-over to our new software, *Hold Short*, has been going very well. We're continuing to tweak it as we go to make sure the bugs are worked out for spring flying.

It is very likely that glider operations will be delayed a bit beyond the powered aircraft due to the foot print with the smaller
